Introduction

Following is a synthesis of the results obtained from the Statistics on Museums and Museum Collections 2012, statistical operation carried out every two years and included in the National Statistics Plan. The statistical operation is developed by the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport in collaboration with the Ministry of Defence, National Heritage and the Regional Governments and Autonomous Cities.

The aim is to offer statistical indicators of these cultural institutions including aspects related to the museum supply, general characteristics, accessibility, infrastructure, facilities, museum deposits, exhibitions or publications among others, as well as related to the demand, especially shown through the estimates of visitors offered.

The main classification variables used in the project are the following: autonomous regions or cities and size of municipality in which the institution is situated, ownership or management, and type of museum or museum collection.

The first heading of this edition includes the main concepts used in the elaboration of the Statistics on Museums and Museum Collections.

The second heading incorporates a brief reference to the main results of the statistics complemented with the results of this sector provided by the Survey on Cultural Habits and Practices.

Finally, it is included the tables with the main results.

The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport expresses its gratitude for the excellent of the various collaboration institutions that have provided the information necessary for the elaboration of this project. The elaboration of this edition would not have been possible without their valuable assistance.

We hope that the results presented become an instrument that will lead to a better knowledge of the museums reality and their evolution.

Main concepts and classifications

Museum. The concept of museum as used in statistics is the one defined by The Law of Spanish Historical Heritage, 16/1985, of June 26, by which "Museums are institutions of a permanent nature that acquire, conserve, research, communicate and exhibit for the purposes of study, education and contemplation, collections that are of historical, artistic, scientific, technical or any other form of cultural value".

Museum collection. For the purposes of statistics, Museum Collections are considered to be "The body of cultural goods which, even though not meeting all the conditions required for the development of the inherent functions of a museum, are exposed to the public in keeping with museum criteria, at fixed visiting hours, and which has a basic set of deposits as well as the means for their conservation and safe keeping".

Type of Museum. The classification of Museums and Museum Collections according to type is in keeping, fundamentally, with what has been established by UNESCO, plus variations derived from the contributions of specialists, fundamentally for adaptation to the reality of each autonomous region. It is as follows:

- *Fine Arts*: contains works of art created fundamentally between Ancient times and the XIX century (architecture, sculpture, painting, drawing, etching and religious art).
- *Decorative arts*: contains works of art of an ornamental nature. Also called applied arts or industrial arts.
- *Contemporary art:* contains works of art done, mainly, in the XX and XXI centuries. Includes cinema and photography.
- Casa-Museo. Museum located in the house or residence of birth of a famous personality.
- *Archaeological:* contains objects, bearing historical and/or artistic values, drawn from excavations, and archaeological discoveries or undertakings. Includes numismatic, glyptic and epigraphic specialities and others.
- *In situ*. Created when certain historical sites (archaeological sites, monuments, in situ examples of the industrial past, etc.) were turned into museums in the place for which they were originally conceived. Includes Centres of Archaeological Interpretation, as long as they have a collection that has original deposits; Nature Interpretation Centres are not included.
- *Historical*. Museums and museum collections that illustrate events or historical periods, personalities, etc., are included in this category, as are military museums, etc.
- *Natural sciences and Natural History*. Contains objects linked to biology, botanical studies, geology, zoology, physical anthropology, palaeontology, mineralogy, ecology, etc.
- *Science and Technology*. Contains objects representative of the evolution of the history of science and technical studies, and also deals with the diffusion of the general principles of the same. Planetariums and scientific centres are not included, save those that may have a Museum or Museum Collection.

- Ethnography and Anthropology. Devoted to preindustrial and contemporary cultures and cultural elements, or those belonging to a recent past. This category includes museums of folklore, of the arts and of popular customs and traditions.
- Specialised museums. Look more specifically at a part of Cultural Heritage not covered in other categories.
- *General*. Museum or Museum Collection that can be identified by more than one of the previously mentioned categories.
- *Others.* Museums that cannot be included in the previous categories.


Autonomous Region.
Geographical classification corresponds to the location of the Museum or Museum Collection, independently of ownership or of the institution responsible for management.

Ownership. Refers to the person or corporate body that features as the possessor of the heritage of the Museum or Museum Collection.


Management institution. Refers to the person or corporate body that features as the responsible for the management of the institution.

Finally it should be pointed out exclusion from the the investigation of the conservation institutes and exhibition galleries that depend on libraries and archive centres; the institutions that exhibit living species, such as botanical gardens and aquariums, nurseries, etc; natural reserves and planetariums and scientific centres, save those that may have a Museum or Museum Collection in the terms used in statistics


Graph 1. Estimated number of visitors to Museums and Museum Collections *(Millions)*

Main results


The results of the statistics are based on the 1.464 Museums and Museum Collections that replied to the statistics, representing a coverage of 95,7% of the total number of museum institutions included in the census, 1.529.

According to the estimates provided by the statistics, the Museums and Museum Collections provided that information received 59 millions visitors in 2012. This figure represents an increase of 2,7% with respect to the previous edition of the statistics in 2010.


Regarding the average number of visits per opened museum, this figure stood at 41.535 in 2012, reaching the maximum in certain types of museum such as *Contemporary art* (99.417), *Science and Technology* (86.316) and *Fine arts* (71.649).


of the Museums Most and Museum Collections investigated are public, 67,8%. 30% are private and 2,3% are mixed museums. public Regarding owned museums, the Local Administration shows the most significant weight with a number museum institutions representing 45,7%. Followed at a great distance are the General Administration of the State, 10,3%, the and Regional Administration, 9,6%. Regarding private owned museums it should be mentioned the weight of ecclesiastical museums representing 10,5% of all investigated.

As regards the type of Museums and Museum Collections investigated, it can be highlighted in percentage terms *Ethnography* and *Anthropology* representing 17,9% and *Fine Arts* 15,5% of the total museums.

These types are followed by *Archaeological*, *General* and *Specialised museums* representing in relative weight 11,8%, 9,8%, and 9,6% respectively. In the central group are situated *Contemporary art museums*, 8,6% and *Historical museums*, 7,6%.

Finally, with relative weights lower than 6,3%, it can be found institutions dedicated to *Casamuseo*, *Natural sciences and Natural History, Science and Technology, In situ*, *Decorative arts* and *Others*, in that order.


The estimated staff of the 1.464 Museums and Museum Collections investigated was 14.118 people, with an average rate of 9,6 per museum institution.

By gender, more than half of the staff are women, 55% and the remaining 45% are male.


By type of working day the most frequent is full-time, 73,1% compared to 26,9% of part-time working day.


By type of employees labour relationship, it can be distinguished between those who are remunerated with permanent contract, 71,8%, or temporary contract, 15,9%, and those who are not remunerated, 4,9%. The volunteer staff has also a significant weight, 7,4%.

Accessibility

97,1% of the institutions investigated were opened during 2012 and 2,9% were provisionally closed. Among the opened 87.1% were museums. permanently opened and with incidence, 5,3% were seasonally opened.

The access is not restricted in 99,4% of the institutions, being restricted in the remaining 0,6%. In 49,7% of the Museums and Museum Collections is not required a prior authorisation to visit them and in 40,8% of the museums is only required for groups.


The most frequent work time schedule is from Tuesdays to Fridays, days in which 84,7% of the institutions are opened. A significant lower percentage of institutions, 30,5%, open on Mondays. The activity is intense on weekends, 82,4%, while the percentage of museums that open on holidays is lower, 60,5%.

43,6% of the institutions have exclusively free entrance fee. Most of the museums with entrance fee, 56,4%, offer reduced fee, 43,9%, or free tickets to certain groups, 40,2%, being as the targeted groups seniors and students in reduced fees and child in free tickets.


Among the 769 museums with general fee, in 21,3% the price is less than two euros, in 46,6% is between two and three euros, being higher in 32,1% of the institutions.

Graph 8. Museums and Museum Collections according to the organization of temporary exhibitions by type



Exhibitions and museum deposits

Nearly half of the institutions surveyed, 48,1%, held temporary exhibitions in 2012. This indicator is at its highest in *Contemporary art*, 73,8%, followed by *General museums*, 64,6%, *Specialised museums*, 57,1%, *Science and technology*, 53,6% an *Decorative arts*, 51,5%.

The Museum deposits refer to the 1.333 Museums and Museum Collections that gave information in 2012. It is important to take into account this fact when assessing the results because the large variability observed between the different types of and museums the scarce relationship with other variables make it impossible to extrapolate the total number of museum deposits.


The results indicate that each institution has 32.426 deposits on average, most of them belong to the permanent collection, 85%. The highest rates of deposits per museum are observed in the museum type *Natural sciences and Natural History* (257.294).

Activities


Educational activities have a great weight in these institutions. 57,7% of the museums offer this type of activities, which are mainly targeted to children. Followed at a great distance in terms of frequency, other activities such as courses or seminars, 33,1%, conferences, 32,7% and concerts, 25,7% are held.

Services and facilities

The most frequent services and facilities in museum institutions are information on the permanent collection, 75,1%, guided tours, 63,9%, libraries, 43,4%, and access for people with disabilities, 42,7%.


With lower intensity but percentages higher than 30% are venues for educational activities, with 37% of the institutions surveyed, shop/bookstore with 36,7%, conference hall with 35,2% and audiovisual room with 31,8%.

With values lower than 25% are, in the following order, environmental control, restoration workshop, public parking, accessible information for people with disabilities, research rooms, rental of venue for third parties, electronic guides, cafe/restaurant and photo lab.


With regard to the implementation of New Technologies in the museum institutions, nine out of every ten, specifically 89,3%, have computers which are mainly used administrative tasks access to the Internet.

More than three quarters of the Museums and Museum Institutions, 81,7%, have a Website to facilitate services to inform or communicate with the visitors and users and to provide educational activities or on-line tickets sales.

Museum attendance according to the survey on Cultural Habits and Practices

The Survey on Cultural Habits and Practices, official statistics included in the National Statistics Plan carried out every four years by the Ministry, is a research work done from a sample base of 16 thousand people over the age of 15.

The results of the edition 2010-2011 indicate that the annual rate of attendance to the museums stands at 30,6% of the people surveyed.

Attendance rates are similar in men, 30,7%, than in women, 30,5%.

These attendance rates are at their highest in the youngest group, decrease with the age and rise when increasing the level of education.

There is a strong interrelationship between the attendance other cultural museums and Thus in the group activities. analysed, it can be observed an increase of the rates attendance at the theatre, 41,1% compared to 19% of the overall population surveyed, at concerts, 49,6% compared to 30,2%, or at cinema 74.5% compared 49,1%.

These increases are stronger if we focus on the visits to monuments, 82,6% compared to 39,5% of the population surveyed, or with regard to reading rates, 86,3% compared to 58,7%.
